CITY WATER WORKS.—On Saturday last the city water wheel was completed, and notwithstanding the frequent assertions of knowing ones that it would be a failure, proved a success. The wheel is now revolving much better than before it was taken down, furnishing a bountiful supply of water. The mechanical portion of the work reflects credit upon the contractors, Messrs. Perry & Woodworth. The wheel is fifty feet in diameter, with buckets upon each side, which furnish more water than is required for domestic purposes. We understand that the lessees have perfected such arrangements as will in the future prevent any failure of the water.
