**SUICIDE.**—D. Marchesseault committed suicide on yesterday morning by shooting himself, the ball entering near the nose, and passing into the brain.

**SINGULAR ACTION ON THE PART OF THE CORONER'S JURY.**—The Jury convened to inquire into the cause of the death of D. Marchesseault, at the Mayor's office and examined the body. Beside the body was an unsealed letter, which may have been sufficient to clear up the mystery of his death, but the Jury instead of reading it, allowed it to be disposed of by some of the friends of deceased, who for reasons of their own have not made the same public.

**DIED.**—D. Marchesseault, for several years Mayor of this city, died at the Mayor's office, about 7 o'clock, A. M., on the 20th inst.

Mr. M. was a native of Canada, and in early life emigrated to New-Orleans, where he has a brother now living. He was in Mexico during the Mexican war, and came to this country in 1849, and settled in this city in 1853; where he was for several years engaged in business. He was a man of remarkable energy, of strong convictions, and naturally had many enemies, but leaves a host of friends. The friends and acquaintances of the deceased are requested to attend the funeral at 10 o'clock this morning, from his late residence.
