Proceedings of the City Council.

LOS ANGELES, July 6th, 1863.

Council met pursuant to adjournment.—

Present, Messrs. Jose Mascarel, George Dalton, Louis Roder, John Schumacher, A. A. Boyle and D. Botiller.

The President, John King, being absent, Jose Mascarel, Esq., was called to the chair.

Petition of Carlos Moreno, praying for a deed to certain land, was read and referred to committee on lands.

The petition of, Chas. Taylor and others, for an extension of the city water pipes to Ninth street, for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of that locality with water for domestic purposes, was read and referred to a special committee, consisting of Messrs. Dalton, Boyle and Botiller.

Petition of citizens, praying for the opening of certain streets, read and referred to committee on streets.

Proposition of L. D. Gayitt, to build a dam across the Los Angeles river, was read and its consideration postponed until the next meeting.
