# Proceedings of the City Council.

Council met June 17th, 1863.

Present—John King, Jose Mascarel, John Schumacher and A. A. Boyle.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Returns of special election for the election of two Councilmen canvassed, and D. Botilier and G Dalton were declared elected.

Notice of J. S. Griffin, P. Beaudry and S. Lazard, claiming a continuance of the lease of the City water for the further term of six years, read, and placed on file; also, notice of the same parties, advising the Council of the appropriation of certain lands for the purpose of building of Reservoirs. Read and referred to Committee on Lands.

In the matter of the opening of Lemou street, a further appropriation of fifty dollars was made as a compensation to P. Collins, for certain land used for the street.

An ordinance concerning water for the purpose of irrigation, introduced, read, amended and passed.

Adjourned until Monday next.
