AN ORDINANCE

To approve and ratify the contract heretofore made with J. L. Sainsevain, and to provide for the payment of the warrants issued in payment for pipes and work done in the extension of the City Water Works.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1st. The warrants issued in payment of said pipes and material to Jean Luis Sainsevain, or assigns, shall be payable out of the City Water Works Fund, in conformity with said contract, and be paid out of said Fund in the order of their issue.

The said warrants shall be issued as follows, to wit: In eight warrants for seven hundred and one dollars, (\$701 95-100) and ninety-five cents, each one.

The Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to provide for the extension of the City Water Works, and the contract made in accordance therewith, are hereby ratified and approved, and the work done is hereby declared satisfactory, and as such is received.
