Common Council Proceedings.

REGULAR MEETING.

SAN JOSE, Feb. 6th, 1865.

The Mayor and Common Council of the city of San Jose met this evening at 7 o'clock. Mayor Quinby presiding. Present—Ald's. Bonner, Hobson, Magenheimer, Porter and Pomeroy. Absent—Ald. Cory.

The minutes of the preceding meetings were read and approved.

A communication was received from Messrs. Delmas & Poulain in relation to fixing the western line of River street, which was read and referred to Committee on streets.

A petition was received from the property holders on Market square, in relation to improving the same, which was read and referred to Committee on Public Buildings and Land.

A report was received from Mr. Adam Holloway, Chief Engineer of the San Jose Fire Department, which was read and ordered on file.

A message was received from Mayor Quinby, recommending the repeal of the ordinance entitled "An ordinance authorizing the Commissioners of the Funded Debt of the city of San Jose, to convey to Levi Goodrich and others, the old Spanish road commonly called Mill street," passed and approved Oct. 3, 1863, which was read and ordered on file.
