

The Fair Haven Water Works Giving Way.

The effect of the storm on Tuesday was such as to seriously threaten the dam of the Fair Haven Water Company, at Wintergreen Falls. The pressure of the water was so great that a part of the embankment spanning the valley, slid down, and the centre showed a bad crack. The inhabitants in Westville were informed of the danger, and given notice to look out for a deluge if the dam gave way, as many feared it would yesterday. The water in the dam covers about one hundred and fifty acres it is said, and if it should come gushing down the valley great destruction would be caused. The Company were making some efforts yesterday to remove the danger.—*New Haven Journal, Thursday.*
