AN ACT AMENDING A RESOLUTION INCORPORATING THE FARMINGTON WATER COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section two of a resolution incorporating the Farmington Water Company, approved March 28, 1895, is amended to read as follows: The capital stock shall be fifty thousand dollars, and may be increased from time to time to the sum of sixty thousand dollars, divided into shares of twenty-five dollars each. Said stock when issued shall be paid for in eash or its equivalent.
