AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE NEW HAVEN WATER COMPANY.

Resolved by this Assembly: Section 1. That the board of directors of the New Haven Water company shall hereafter consist of nine persons, to be chosen in the manner provided in the charter of said company: provided, however, that the two persons added to said board by this amendment may be chosen by the present board of directors, and if so chosen, shall hold office until the next annual meeting of said company for the choice of directors.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
