Summary of District Heating Systems in the United States, 1877-2020

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This study has identified 480 commercial district heating systems that were built in the United States between 1877 and 2020, with 397 (83%) of those built by 1918. Of the total number built, 68 systems are still operating. Other systems will likely be found and added to this list, but many smaller systems did not leave deep footprints in the historical record. This study does not include several small district heating systems operating in Alaskan villages.

The oldest commercial system still operating began service in Denver in 1880, while a system covering several business blocks in downtown St. Paul was started in 1879 by John Vann and was operating as late as 1913. His system may have become a part of the later Northern States Power district steam system that was sold to District Energy St. Paul in 1981, but that has not been confirmed.

District heating has a very long history, with a system in Chaudes-Aigues, France, having operated continuously since the 14th Century. A few industrial and institutional facilities in the United States used district heating before 1877, including an 1853 system at the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, but the first successful commercial system to heat multiple buildings was built in 1877 by Lockport, New York inventor Birdsill Holly. He secured several patents and formed the Holly Steam Combination Company, Ltd., with Dr. David F. Bishop, Barnett D. Hall, Samuel Rogers, Francis N. Trevor, Isaac H. Babcock and Mortimer M. Southworth. This company had a capital stock of \$25,000 and built nineteen systems by 1881, including several for institutional customers, and proposed additional systems in other cities. Holly's idea attracted several competitors, including several that used hot water and are discussed later in this summary.

Holly's success led to the January 1881 incorporation of the American District Steam Company with a capital of \$10 million. This company continued to develop new plants well into the Twentieth Century and survives as Adsco Manufacturing LLC in Buffalo.

Holly's initial system in Lockport served 40 residences, two larger building, and two steam engines, distributing "live" steam from boilers at 40 psig / 2.8 barg which was typical for early systems. The Holly Company's *Third Annual Announcement* mentions that the new Edison Electric Light "requires steam power in order to generate electricity for his subdivided light" and that numerous small electric generating plants could be supplied from a single Holly steam system. The only known example of this was the second Edison electric station in Manhattan that opened in 1886 at 60 Liberty Street and was driven by steam from the New York Steam Company.

Many buildings used steam engines to run elevators and manufacturing processes and in 1887 the New York Steam Company was reportedly serving 435 engines. As late as 1890 the American District Steam Company envisioned a future of small distributed electric generators powered by district steam systems.

Holly wanted to capitalize on this concept by introducing the "Holly Double System" in Lynn, Massachusetts and New Haven, Connecticut in 1880. This system employed a dual pressure network, with live steam at 70 psig / 4.8 barg powering customer's steam engines, and the exhaust steam at 5 to 10 psig / $\frac{1}{3}$ to $\frac{2}{3}$ barg was them sold to heat other buildings through a separate low-pressure pipeline network. The Lynn plant only operated for a short period, but the idea of distributing exhaust steam from electric light plants would become very popular.

The earliest recorded instance of an electric light company selling exhaust steam was the Edison Electric Illumination Company of Lawrence, Massachusetts in August 1885 and several were doing so by 1890. Many early electric companies sold power for arc lights and street lighting and only operated from sunset to 10 pm or midnight. As their customers adopted appliances and electric motors 24-hour service became the norm, greatly expanding the opportunity to use exhaust steam for heating. Articles about exhaust steam heating from electric plants began to appear in engineering journals in 1891, and the following year the American District Steam Company published an updated pamphlet that highlighted the advantages of exhaust steam heating. Exhaust steam installations expanded rapidly, with 33 systems built in the peak year of 1901. The number of systems operating reached a peak of 352 in 1916, almost all of which operated in conjunction with electric light plants. Only about five percent of the 6,543 commercial and municipal central electric stations then in operation used district heating. Although most of these systems distributed steam, 61 low temperature hot water systems were built between 1894 and 1920, which is discussed in the last section of this summary. In 2020 only three electric utilities utilize district heating.


World War I was a watershed for the district heating industry. Wartime coal shortages and price inflation drove many small systems out of business. After the war, consolidation of the electric industry accelerated with the construction of large hydroelectric plants and condensing steam generating units. Improvements in electric transmission networks allowed this cheaper power to be delivered over longer distances, making many small electric plants uneconomical even with exhaust steam service. These trends led to a gradual decline in the number of operating district heating systems as shown on the accompanying graph.

A small uptick in plant construction occurred in the 1920s and 1930s, but after 1951 no new district systems were built until the natural gas industry began building district heating and cooling systems in the 1960s to gain market share from electric utilities. The Clean Air Act of 1970 forced many plants to convert to oil, while the oil shocks of the 1970s resulted in significant fuel price increases while leading to the realization that energy supplies and energy conservation are vital to national security. Federal and state governments funded dozens of studies to preserve existing district heating systems and build new ones, but with limited success. Several geothermal district heating systems were built and European hot water piping systems were introduced as discussed in the last section of this summary.



Ownership of Multiple District Heating Systems

The first district heating companies were owned by local investors who anticipated benefits for their communities and themselves. This also held true for the earliest electric companies, but starting around 1890 electric utilities began to take advantage of improved generation and transmission technologies by absorbing small local companies into larger networks that morphed into large holding companies. Increasing demands for power led utilities to keep smaller plants in operation even as larger, lower-cost plants came online, but over time smaller steam-generation units were moved into reserve duty and eventually retired. This also ended the life of many small district heating systems that relied on low-cost exhaust steam. Although customers in some communities made attempts to take over and operate the systems on a cooperative basis, these could not operate on a paying basis.

This process played out over several decades, and many larger utilities ended up owning multiple district heating systems. In 1916, for instance, Hodenpyl, Hardy & Co., organized quarterly meetings of the steam superintendents of its companies in Michigan, Indiana, Illinois and Ohio. Eight companies were represented at the first meeting in Peoria in September of that year. Others owning multiple systems included:

- The Illinois Power & Light Corporation owned 14 systems in Bloomington, Champaign, Clinton, Danville, Decatur, Galesburg, Hillsboro, LaSalle, Monmouth, Monticello, Morrisonville, Morton, Mt. Vernon, and Urbana.
- Central Illinois Public Service Company owned systems in Canton, Carrolton, Charleston, Hoopestown, Jerseyville, Mattoon, Pana, Paris, Paxton, Quincy, Taylorville, Tuscola, and Virden.
- Iowa Electric Light & Power Company owned systems in Cedar Rapids, Boone, Perry, Marion, Manchester, Iowa Falls, Eldora, Spirit Lake, Marshalltown, and Vinton.

The Overbrook Steam Heat Company was formed in 1893 by Lewis Jones to heat residences in that planned community in Philadelphia. He died in 1917 and his son, Lewis Jones, Jr., formed Lewis Jones, Inc. the following year to own the system. He formed a second system in 1929 to provide heating in Overbrook Hills, Green Hill Farms and Penn Wynne in Lower Merion Township, Montgomery County. Jones died in 1945 and his estate set up the Lewis Jones Management Company to oversee the systems. In 1952 this company bought the system in Wilkes-Barre from the Scranton-Spring Brook Water Company, which had acquired it from Pennsylvania Power and Light the previous year. The Lewis Jones Management Company was sold in 1955 to the Pennsylvania Utilities Investment Corporation, and that company bought the Scranton steam system from Pennsylvania Power and Light in 1956. The systems were bought by General Waterworks Corporation in 1966, which bought the Longacre Park Heating Company in the Borough of Yeadon, Delaware County shortly thereafter. General Waterworks petitioned the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission to abandon the five systems in February 1972, but withdrew the request a month later and they had decided to sell the systems to Arthur G. Crimmins and two other individuals who formed International Service Industries. According to a January 10, 1973 article in the Wall Street Journal, Crimmins and his colleagues took over the systems in March and began paying themselves salaries of \$50,000 while renting expensive automobiles using the steam company's earnings. In June, the remnants of Hurricane Agnes caused extensive damage to the Wilkes-Barre system, requiring it to be rebuilt at substantial cost. Unsurprisingly, International Service Industries declared bankruptcy in November. The three suburban systems ceased operating, while the Scranton system was acquired by the Community Central Energy Corporation and operated until 2006. A steam heat authority was formed to take over the Wilkes-Barre system, which managed to survive until 1990 despite having installed the first fluidized bed boiler used in a district heating system.

Ohio Edison owned systems in Akron, Springfield and Youngstown that it had decided to sell or close down in 1980. Springfield was shut down, the City of Akron bought the system in that city, and Carl E. Avers, Jr. formed Youngstown Thermal Corporation to acquire that system for about \$1 million as a subsidiary of Synergy Systems Management Corporation of Coral Gables, Florida. Avers was able to buy the steam system in St. Louis in December, 1984 for \$3 million and the system in Baltimore the following March for \$10 million with Catalyst Energy Development Corporation as a financial partner. This steam then acquired the Boston steam system on February 6, 1986 for \$32.5 million and the Philadelphia system on January 30, 1986 for \$30 million. The steam system in Cleveland was also acquired in December, 1987. The following July Thomas B. Pickens 3d (son of T. Boone Pickens) bought control of Catalyst Energy for \$202.5 million and Catalyst Energy became United Thermal Corporation. The system in Cleveland was sold shortly thereafter to Mid-America Energy Resources, a subsidiary of Indianapolis Power and Light (IPALCO).

Avers left United Thermal around this time but retained the Youngstown system. He founded Thermal Ventures (TVI) in 1989 and secured contracts to operate steam systems in Pittsburgh and San Francisco. TVI bought these two systems in 1993 for \$16.4 million and sold 50% of these companies to NRG Energy in 1995. TVI also leased the steam system in Akron that year. TVI sold the remaining 50% to NRG Energy in 1999, while keeping Youngstown and the lease in Akron. The system in Detroit was acquired in 2002.

In addition to the two systems bought from TVI, NRG Energy bought the Minneapolis system in 1993, Pittsburgh in 1999, Harrisburg in 2000 and Omaha in 2013. NRG Energy was acquired in 2018 by Clearway Energy.

Thomas R. Casten was named director of corporate strategy for Cummins Engine Company in 1974 and head of Cummins Cogeneration Company in 1977. After selling only six systems in a very tough market, Casten and his partners bought Cummins Cogeneration in 1980 and renamed it Cogeneration Development Corporation, which would act as a developer of district energy systems. They built a system in Trenton, New Jersey and also proposed other systems in cities such as Rochester. Cogeneration Development teamed with ELYO, the energy arm of French water company Societé Lyonnaise des Eaux, to create Trigen Energy in 1986. Trigen bought systems in Hempstead, New York, Tulsa and Oklahoma City in 1989 and in 1993 acquired United Thermal Corporation for \$65 million. Trigen bought the Kansas City steam system in 1990 and two systems in Los Angeles in 2006.

Veolia Energy entered the U.S. market by buying the steam system in Cambridge in 2005 and bought Trigen in 2007 and the steam system in Grand Rapids in 2008. Trigen was renamed Veolia Energy in 2011. Veolia was bought by Vicinity Energy in December 2019.

The district energy assets of Enwave Energy were renamed CenTrio in 2021.

Hot Water District Heating

Although steam was by far the most popular type of district heating service, William E. Prall built a high-temperature hot water demonstration plant at 256 West 125th street in New York city, where his Prall Union Heating Company hosted a meal for the American Society of Civil Engineers on November 11, 1880 with food was cooked using 400°F/204°C superheated water. Prall was unable to gain financial backing until Theodore N. Vail formed the National Heating Company and built plants in Washington, D. C. and Boston. Companies were also formed in several other cities. The Boston plant operated from January 1888 to November 1889 before shutting down due to corrosion in the return water lines to the plant.

Between 1894 and 1910, sixty-one low-temperature (< 212°F/100°C) hot water systems were built, with most using exhaust heat from electric light plants. The most widespread was the Yaryan system, developed by Homer T. Yaryan. Others were designed and installed by Evans Almirall & Co. (Quimby N. Evans and Juan A. Almirall), Isaac D. Smead, and William E. Schott. A few of these systems remained in service for over 50 years, with the last one in Perry, Iowa shutting down in June 1981 after supplying heat for 81 years. Several early hot water systems had short operating lives, and a few were converted to steam, usually when a system was sold to a new owner who was more familiar with steam. Substantial information has been found for many of these systems, which share many operating characteristics with modern European hot water designs but relied on crude piping materials. The inability to meter hot water energy consumption was a major drawback to wider use of these systems, and customer charges were based on the square feet of installed radiation in each building. A list of these systems is shown on the attached list.

Nine commercial geothermal district heating systems have been built, starting with the first in Boise in 1892. Most of these are direct-use system, but the latest one, in West Union, Iowa, distributes water at 55°F/12.8°C, with heat pumps in each customer building used for space heating and cooling. These systems are designed on the attached list with a "G" followed by the chronological sequence in the HW column.

High-temperature hot water systems were introduced in the late 1879s but were unsuccessful. Improved systems were widely adopted in military and institutional systems after the second world war, but only five recent commercial systems have used this technology, a 1964 Texas system, two in Los Angeles built in 1966, one on Long Island in 1972, and another built in Trenton in 1983. These systems are designed on the attached list with an "H" followed by the chronological sequence in the HW column.

European pre-insulated piping systems designed to meet EN-253 have been used in several district heating systems, including ten commercial networks. Four of these converted existing steam distribution piping to hot water and the remaining five were new systems. Three of these ten systems have been abandoned. These are designed on the attached list with an "E" followed by the chronological sequence in the HW column.

The hot water systems listed in the table on the following pages are sorted by the four types of hot water systems described above.
