

Chester Steam Heating Company.

The Chester Steam Heating Company is preparing to get under way and an organization has been effected by the election of G. P. Deale chairman and Captain F. O. Sweeney secretary. It was decided to send a committee to New Haven, Conn., where the steam heating system is in successful operation and inspect it, ascertain cost of working, plant and other facts. The committee has not yet been named. Between \$2,000 and \$10,000 have already been subscribed, and about \$25,000 is desired. The company propose to lay mains on Third street as far as Third street bridge, up Market to Sixth and then on Edgemont avenue to Broad, with lateral lines, if needed, to accommodate persons not on the thoroughfares named. Steam will be furnished at moderate cost, thus doing away with the danger and trouble of a boiler in offices, stores and dwellings.
