

# **Notice of Formation of the Dubuque Water Works Company.**

A corporation has been formed under the laws of the State of Iowa under the name of the Dubuque Water Works Company, having its principal place of business in the City of Dubuque, Iowa. The general nature of the business of the Company is the building, maintaining and operating water works in the City of Dubuque, State of Iowa.

Amount of capital stock authorized is Three Hundred Thousand Dollars, in shares of One Hundred dollars each, payable in installments of five per cent., and not oftener than once in thirty days.

The corporation commenced on the 20th day of July, 1870, and will terminate in fifty years, unless renewed in accordance with law. The affairs of the company are to be conducted by a board of eleven directors. The present provisional board shall hold their office until the fifth day of Sept., A. D. 1870, at which time their successors will be elected, who will hold their office until the second Monday in January, 1872, and that an annual election will be held upon the second Monday of January of each succeeding year. The Board of Directors are authorized to appoint such other officers and agents as they may deem necessary.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation is at any time to subject itself is one hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

The private property of the stockholders is to be exempt from the corporate debts.
