be chosen by the Governor, one by the company, and the third, by the two chosen as aforesaid; and, in ascertaining said value, the books of the company may be used as evidence of the quantity and kind of work executed, but not as evidence of the value thereof. The locomotives, engines, cars and other machiner y and implements used, by the company on said road, shall be surrendered to the State Borrender of property.

SEC. 2. To enable the company to construct and put in opera- conitst stock. tion the road aforesaid, the capital stock of said company may be increased one million of dollars, to be divided into shores of one hundred dollars, and disposed of under the direction of the said company.

SEC. 8. The soid road shall continue to be a public road, and Public road, the lows of the Stote new in force, or which may bereafter be in force, having for their object the protection and preservation of publie roads, and the trial and punishment of persons for infuriou to minutes. such roads or their appurtenances, shall be applicable to said road, in the possession of said company, to be ascertained by persons chosen to value the sume, as required in relation to the road.

Szc. 4. The soid company shall have all the rights and powers nights. over said road, and, with reference to its use, the transportation of persons and property thereon, that have licen or may be granted or conforred, with reference to the road from Springfield to the Illinois river, and the right to construct a double trock, or railway, upon the whole or any part of said road, is hereby granted and conferred upon said company.

AN ACT to arrent on set entitled "An set to incorporate the Late Michigan Hydrautic In face, Companys" opproved March 1, 1946. Fables 28, 1847.

SECTION 1. Be il enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly, That, in uddition to the howers, conferred upon the said " Luke Michigan Hydraulie company," by the said act of incorporation, the said company shall have the right and are hereby authorized to use any surplus steam or other power, which they may create and have, to carry on the munufocture of flour, lumber, woolen and cotton goods, or such other kinds of mechanical and manufacturing business as they may deem proper, and find it for their interest to do; and to purchase the necessary land, and thereon to creet all necessary buildings, machinery and improvements, for the prosecution of the same.
