

# NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS.

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Secretary of the Board of Water Commissioners of the city of Springfield, until the 15th day of June, 1866, for the construction of Water Works in the city of Springfield, Illinois, comprising Engine House, Engines and Pumps, Force and Distributing Mains of cast iron, Embankment Reservoir, Stand Pipe, &c., in accordance with certain plans and specifications, which can be seen at the office of the Secretary of the Board, and also at the office of Joseph Barnshaw, Civil Engineer, Cincinnati, Ohio.

Proposals will be received either for the entire work put in complete running order, or for separate portions thereof, viz: Such as building reservoir, furnishing pipe, castings, laying the same, building engine house, furnishing and putting up boilers, engines and pumping machinery in complete running order.

Each bid must be accompanied by two good and sufficient sureties in double the amount of the contract, conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract should it be awarded.

The Board of Commissioners reserving to themselves the right to accept or reject any, or all bids presented should they deem it advisable to do so.
