

STAND-PIPE SUITS.

VERDICT FOR LARGE DAMAGES OVER A STREET LOCATION.

The City of Sycamore Mulcted at the
End of Long Litigation—Verdict for
\$1,200—Several More Law Suits Wait-
ing.

Sycamore, Ill., March 6.—(Special.)—
A jury in the circuit court, now in ses-
sion in this city, awarded Szrah J. Bar-
rows \$1,200 damages against the city
for placing its water works standpipe
in the street adjoining the hotel. This
case was appealed from the circuit to
the appellate court on a writ of de-
murrer, the appellate court affirming
the decision of the circuit court; ap-
pealed to the supreme court the decis-
ion was reversed and the case remanded
to the circuit court, where, after a jury
trial, a verdict was rendered Thursday.
Other suits by adjoining property own-
ers will be brought against the city.
