Articles of Association of the Indianapolis
Water Works Company.

Be it known that by virtue of an act of the
General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
approved March 6th 1865, entitled, "An Act
to authorize the formation of companies
for the construction of Water Works in
and for incorporated cities to enable
such cities to subscribe Stock in such
Companies and to issue and sell
bonds for the payment thereof," the under-
signed subscribers and stockholders
hereby form themselves into a corporation
and adopt and subscribe the following
certificate of incorporation and articles

of association.

Article 1st The corporate name of said Company shall be "The Indianapolis Water Works Company"

Article 2nd The capital stock of said company shall be One Million dollars, which shall be divided into ten thousand shares of one hundred dollars each.

Article 3rd The corporate existence of said Company shall be for the term of fifty years.

Article 4th There shall be nine Directors elected annually from and by the Stockholders of said company, and the following nine Stockholders are hereby designated as Directors to manage the affairs of

said Company for one year and until
their successors are elected and qualified.

To wit: O. P. Morton, Valentine Butcher,

William Braden, John Carhilo, John S.

Parkington, E. B. Martindale, A. T. Roberts, Henry
H. Catherwood and Robert B. Catherwood.

Article 5th Said Company is organized in and
for the City of Indianapolis, in the County
of Marion, State of Indiana, and the
vicinity of said city.

Article 6th The business of said company shall
be that of furnishing water, which it
may do to the City and citizens of
Indianapolis, the State, public insti-
tutions, corporations, institutions, firms

and individuals, and all desiring the
same in said city and the vicinity thereof,
for whatsoever purpose

Now, therefore, we whose names are
hereunto subscribed agree to take, and pay
for on the order of the Board of Directors
of said Company, the number of shares
and amount in dollars set opposite
our respective names in the Capital
stock of the Indianapolis Water
Works Company, which said sum
we promise to pay without
any relief whatever from valu-

ation or appraisement laws.
