Chap. 220 AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF THE ACT FOR SUPPLYING THE CITY OF BOSTON WITH PURE WATER.

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

Penalty for diereased.

The fifteenth section of the act entitled "An Section 1. verting or cor-rupting water in- Act for supplying the City of Boston with Pure Water," passed the thirtieth day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words, viz.: "or by confinement to hard labor in the state prison for a term not exceeding ten years."

> Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage. Approved May 23, 1861.

Chap, 221 An Act in further addition to an act making appropriations TO MEET CERTAIN EXPENDITURES AUTHORIZED THE PRESENT YEAR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

Appropriations authorized.

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated and shall be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, upon the warrants of the governor, for the purposes specified, as follows, namely:

Transportation of paupers.

Inspector of gas meters, salary.

Land agent, salary.

Eye and ear infirmary.

Todd school fund, income of.

Indians' school fund.

Essex bridge, repairs of.

For the transportation of state paupers, one hundred dollars.

For the salary and expenses of the inspector of gas meters, a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars, in accordance with the provisions of chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

For the salary of the land agent for the first quarter of the present year, two hundred and fifty dollars; and for incidental expenses of his office, ten dollars.

For the Massachusetts Charitable Eye and Ear Infirmary, the further sum of five hundred dollars.

The income of the Todd normal school fund shall be paid to the treasurer of the board of education, to be applied in such manner as shall be prescribed by said board, in accordance with chapter thirty-six of the General Statutes.

The income of the Indians' school fund shall be applied according to the provisions of chapter thirty-six of the General Statutes.

For deficiency in the appropriation for repairs of the Essex bridge, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty, six hundred fifty-two dollars and fifty-four cents, to be paid from the Essex bridge fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
