CHAP. XCI.

An act in addition to an act, entitled, " An act to incorporate Rufus Davenport, and others, by the name of the Cambridge Port Aqueduct Corporation."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Reprefentatives, in General Court affembled, and by the authority of the the same, That the Cambridge Port Aqueduct Corporation, Empowered to may be, and hereby is authorized and empowered to pur-purchase and chafe, hold, and use, in such manner, and for such purposes, hold lands. as are described in the act to which this is an addition, a certain piece or parcel of land, supposed to contain springs, on or by the hills near the house of Mr. Peter Tufts, in Medford; and the faid corporation may also purchase and hold in manner aforefaid, one or more piece or pieces of land which the faid corporation shall require; Provided, that all the land fo purchased and holden by said corporation, shall not in quantity exceed fix hundred feet fquare; and for the purposes aforesaid, a meeting of the proprietors may be called and held, in the manner provided in the act to which this is an addition.

CHAP. XCII.

An act to incorporate Benjamin Lincoln, and others, into a Society, for the purpose of building a Meeting-House, for public religious worship, in the north parish of Hingham, in the county of Plymouth.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Reprefentatives, in General Court affembled, and by the authority of the same, That Benjamin Lincoln, Nathan Rice, Abner Lincoln, Persons incor and Levi Lincoln, junior, their affociates and fucceffors, be, porated. and they hereby are constituted and made a corporation and body politic, by the name of the New North Meeting-House Corporation; shall, by that name, sue and be fued, shall have a common feal, and may also ordain and establish fuch by-laws and regulations, as to them shall seem necessary and convenient for the government of faid corporation: Provided, fuch by-laws and regulations shall be in no wife Proviso. contrary to the Laws and Constitution of this Commongealth; may purchase and hold land for the erection of a
