

MILFORD.

The selectmen and engineers held a meeting Tuesday evening and voted to give the water works a thorough trial next Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock, and invite the fire department to be present and assist. According to the contract, six streams are to be thrown over the highest building, and Music Hall has been selected. The hydrants situated in other parts of the town are to be thoroughly tested. The steamers and hand engines will not be attached to the hydrants, but the men will assist on the hose. The day will be a gala day in town, and many visitors will be present from adjoining towns. An indicator will be placed in the Milford steamer house, enabling one to tell at any time the water pressure on the pipes. Saturday the pressure will be 150 pounds.
