

An Ordinance Providing for the Erection of Water Works.

It is ordained by the Common Council of the City of Kansas:

1st. That for the purpose of providing the City of Kansas with water by the erection of suitable water works, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars in bonds of the City of Kansas be and the same are hereby appropriated.

2nd. That said bonds shall bear date July 1st, 1876, and be made payable on the first day of January, A. D., 1891, and shall bear 7 per cent. interest per annum, payable semi-annually in the city of New York in gold.

3rd. That the disposition of said bonds shall be under the control of the Finance Committee of this Council, after they are properly issued, subject to the provisions the charter regulating the sale thereof.

4th. That the Committee on Public Works, in connection with the Mayor, be authorized to invite propositions for the building of a suitable system of water works for the City of Kansas and to bring the same before the Common Council for their consideration as soon as received.

5th. That all the revenue arising from rents charged for the supplying of water from such water works, after defraying the necessary current expenses pertaining thereto, shall be set aside as a special fund to pay the interest on said bonds issued for said water works, and the remainder be used as a sinking fund to pay said bonds at their maturity.

6th. That the Mayor be and is hereby instructed to submit this ordinance and proposition to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Kansas on the 4th day of June, 1876; that the ballot for such proposition shall be "For the issuing of Bonds for Water Works—Yes" "For the issuing of Bonds for Water Works—No."
