Articles of Association
of the
Kansas City Water Works Company

Be it known that by an act of the General Assembly of the State of Missouri authorizing the organization of corporations for the purpose of supplying any Town City, District, Neighborhood or Village with Gas or Water defining the powers and privileges thereof the undersigned subscribers and stockholders hereby form themselves into a corporation and adopt and subscribe the following Certificate of incorporation and Association,

Article 1st The corporate name of said company shall be "Kansas City Water Works Company"

Article 2, The capital stock of said company shall be (\$300,000) Three hundred thousand dollars which shall be divided into Six thousand shares of fifty dollars each

Article 3, The corporate existence of said company shall be for the term of fifty years

Article 4, There shall be three directors elected, ^{Annually} from and by the stockholders of said company.

And the following named stock holders are hereby designated as directors to manage the affairs of said company for one year and until their successors are elected and qualified to wit. James O Woodruff Eric Locke + Kersey Coates,

Article 5. Said company is organized in and for the city of Kansas, County of Jackson State of Missouri and the vicinity of said city

Article 6. The business of said company shall be that of furnishing water which it may do to the city and citizens of the city of Kansas and all desiring the same in said city and vicinity thereof for whatever purposes, Now therefore we whose names are hereunto subscribed agree to take and pay for on the order of the board of directors of said company the number of shares and the amount in dollars set opposite our respective names in the capital stock of the "Kansas City Water Works Company" which said sum we promise to pay without any relief from valuation or appraisement laws.
