CHAPTER 1495.

AN ACT to increase the capital stock of the Blodgett Paper Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened,* That the capital stock of the Blodgett Paper Company may be increased two hundred thousand dollars in addition to the present capital of one hundred thousand dollars, making the whole capital of said company not to exceed the sum of three hundred thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon the passage thereof.

SEC. 3. The legislature may alter, amend or repeal this act, whenever the public good shall require alteration, amendment or repeal.

Approved, June 30, 1853.

CHAPTER 1496

AN ACT to amend the charter and change the name of the Nashville Aqueduct.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened,* That the capital stock of said corporation shall consist of a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and that said corporation is hereby empowered to purchase and hold real estate not exceeding in value the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, and that the limitations, in the charter of said corporation, of the capital stock to a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars, and the power to purchase and hold real estate to a value not exceeding the sum of six thousand dollars, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. The said corporation shall hereafter be known in law by the name of the Pennichuck Water Works.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage, and may be altered, amended or repealed, whenever the public good may require.
