CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT TO REVIVE THE CHARTER OF THE PETERBOROUGH WATER-
WORKS COMPANY.

SECTION

1. Act revived and continued.

SECTION

2. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

SECTION 1. The act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Peterborough Water-Works Company," passed by the legislature at the session of 1891, is hereby revived and continued in force as fully and completely, to all intents and purposes, as if the same were reenacted at the present time, and the corporation thereby created shall continue from the passage of this act. Act revived and continued.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage. Takes effect.

CHAPTER 133.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF THE CHARTER OF THE LOWER BARTLETT
CEMETERY.

SECTION

1. Charter amended; authority conferred.

SECTION

2. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2,309 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1859 is hereby amended as follows: Strike out all after the word "shall" in the first line of section 2, and insert in the place thereof the following—have authority to dispose of lots therein for the improvement of said cemetery—so that said section as amended shall read as follows: Said company shall have authority to dispose of lots therein for the improvement of said cemetery. Charter amended; authority conferred.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from its passage.
