## AN ACT to divorce Almira S. Douglass from her husband Thomas W. Douglass.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and General Assembly of this State, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Almira S. Douglass be, and she is hereby divorced from T.W.Douglass her husband, Thomas W. Douglass, and that the marriage and A.S. Doucontract heretofore existing between the said Almira S. Dou- glass divorced. glass and her husband, Thomas W. Douglass, be, and the same is hereby dissolved, as fully to all intents and purposes as if they had never been joined in matrimony.

## A SUPPLEMENT to the Act entitled "An Act to incor-

porate the Bordentown Water Company," passed Febru-

ary thirteenth, eighteen hundred and thirty-five.

Sec. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Council and General Assembly of this State, and it is hereby enacted by the authority Bordentown of the same, That at any time after twenty years from the passage of this act, the borough of Bordentown, in its corporate capacity, may take from the company incorporated by the act to which this is a supplement, all the right, title and interest of the company aforesaid, by paying first cost therefor. with interest thereon.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the sixth section of the act to which this is a supplement, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
