CHAPTER CCCLXIV.

A Further Supplement to an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Passaic Water Company," approved February thirteenth, eighteen hunred and forty-nine.

Capital stock may be iucreased. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jeresy, That the Passaic Water Company be and they are hereby authorized to increase their capital stock to the sum of five hundred thousand dollars, at such time or times and in such manner as the board of directors of said company, or a majority of them, may deem proper.

2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect immediately.
