SEVENTY-FOURTH SESSION.

Chap. 211.

AN ACT authorizing county clerks to appoint special deputies.

Passed April 17, 1851.

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The clerk of each county in this state, is hereby authorized to appoint some suitable person as special deputy, who shall possess the same power and authority as the said clerk, to attend and do all things in and about the courts of said county.

§ 2. Such appointment shall be in writing, and be filed in the clerk's office of the county; and such special deputy, before he enters upon the duties of his office, shall take the oath required by the constitution and laws of this state, and shall hold his office during the pleasure of such clerk.

 \S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 212.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act for a supply of water in the city of Albany," passed April 9, 1850.

Passed April 17, 1851, "three-fifths being present."

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

§ 1. The fifth section of the "Act for a supply of water in the city of Albany," passed April 9, 1850, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following: "a portion of the said water stock, not exceeding one half thereof, may be made payable at such times, not exceeding thirty years from the time of issuing the same, as the said common council shall direct."

§ 2. If it shall be found necessary to incur expenses not now contemplated in the execution of said act, the amount of said water stock may be increased, by the common council of the city of Albany, not more than fifty thousand dollars.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
