Chap. 5.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to provide for a supply of water in the city of Albany, and to make a loan therefor," passed April 9, 1850.

Passed January 28th, 1857, three-fifths being present. The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. It shall be lawful for the common council of the city of Albany, by a vote of two-thirds of their number, to raise by loan from time to time, as the same may be required, the sum of fifty thousand dollars by increasing "the water stock of the city of Albany," which the said common council were authorised to create by the fifth section of the act hereby amended. The said increase of stock shall bear an interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum; and the principal be payable at such time as the said common council shall determine, not exceeding thirty years from the time of issuing said stock.

§ 2. The moneys authorised to be raised by virtue of this act, shall be applied by the water commissioners of the city of Albany to the extension or improvement of the water works of said city whenever such extension or improvement shall be required by the common council of said city in the manner now provided by law.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 6.

AN ACT to authorise the city of Syracuse to borrow money.

Passed January 30, 1857, three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
