District attorney to prosecute. have control, he shall be deemed guilty of a felony. And it shall be the duty of the district attorney of any county within which such offender resides, upon the complaint of the commanding officer of a brigade, regiment, battalion or separate troop or battery located in such county, to prosecute such offender in any court of competent civil jurisdiction. Any penalty incurred and paid or collected under this section shall be paid into the treasury of the said county, and belong to the military fund of the regiment, battalion, or separate troop or battery to which the offender belongs, or in which the case may have arisen.

Repeal.

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§ 268. Chapter four hundred and seventy-seven of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled "An act to provide for the enrollment of the militia, the organization and discipline of the National Guard of the State of New York, and for the public detense," and all the acts amendatory of the same, and all other acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed, but such repeal shall not affect any legal proceedings commenced under such conflicting acts.

§ 269. This act shall be entitled the Military Code, and shall take effect immediately.

Chap 81.

AN ACT relative to the water debt of the village of Ballston Spa.

PASSED March 17, 1870; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Payment of village bonds.

SECTION 1. The trustees of the village of Ballston Spa are authorized and required to provide for the payment of the several bonds that have been or shall be issued by the president and trustees of said village, within the limitation and for the purposes specified in the act entitled "An act to amend and consolidate the several acts relative to the village of Ballston Spa," passed April twelve, eighteen hundred and fifty-five, passed May ninth, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and also in the act entitled "An act relative to the village of Ballston Spa," passed April twenty-nine, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, as provided in the sixth section of the said first mentioned

act. But the said officers are authorized from time to Issue of new bonds time to borrow on the credit of the said village, and issue topay water new bonds, to be paid as provided in the said section, for the purpose of raising money for the payment of so much when payof the principal of the water debt of said village, falling due in any year as shall exceed one thousand dollars, and so that no more than one thousand dollars of the said principal, together with the interest on the whole debt, shall be required to be annually collected and paid. The proceedings of the village meetings, at which the said Vote of vilwater debt was voted, are hereby ratified and legalized, in so far as relates to the said debt.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 82.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Elmira.

PASSED March 17, 1870; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes by the Time excollector of the city of Elmira in the county of Chemung tended to June first. is hereby extended until the first day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy; provided, however, that, on or before the twentieth day of March instant, the said collector shall pay over all moneys by him collected, and renew his bonds to the satisfaction of the supervisors, one collector to or more of them, of the said city.
