Map contracts and vouchers, to be filed with street commissioners. Board, when to be dissolved. the office of the street commissioner of the said city all maps, profiles, contracts and vouchers made or received by them in pursuance of said acts, and the said board shall be dissolved from and after the said first day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, and any further work to be done shall devolve upon the said common council.

§ 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 760.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to provide a supply of water in the city of Buffalo," passed May seventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Passed May 8, 1869; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section seven of an act entitled "An act to provide a supply of water in the city of Buffalo," passed May seventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, is hereby amended by striking out of the same the fellowing words: The expense of extending and putting down pipes or mains, and of furnishing or constructing hydrants in connection with pipes so extended or put down, shall be borne and defrayed by local assessments therefor on the property deemed benefited thereby, and not otherwise.

Issue of city bonds, authorized, for cost of extension of water works.

§ 2. The common council of the city of Buffalo are hereby authorized and directed to cause the bonds of said city to be issued for an amount sufficient to pay the cost of the extensions of the water works of said city made during the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, bearing interest and payable as provided in the first section of said act, the proceeds of which bonds shall be applied to the reimbursement of the water fund (secalled) of said city for the cost of such extensions.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
