CHAP. 601.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Buffalo to issue its bonds for the purpose of extending the supply of water to the city and its inhabitants, and to purchase land and to construct a reservoir thereon.

PASSED May 23, 1873; three-fifths being present.

The Prople of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, ile chact as follows:

leane of bonda.

Amount Section I. It shall be lawful for the common council of the city of raped and Buffalo to raise an amount not to exceed in the aggregate six hundred thousand dollars, three hundred thousand dollars of which shall be used exclusively for the supply of water to the city and its inhabitants, and three hundred thousand dollars for the purpose of purchasing land for a reservoir and constructing the same. And for such purposes it shall be lawful for the common council of said city, by a vote of two-thirds of the members thereof, from time to time, to authorise the issue of the bonds of the said city to an amount not to exceed six hundred thousand dollars in the aggregate, in addition to the amount now authorized by law to be issued, hearing inferest at the rate of seven per centum per annum, the interest to be paid semi-unually in the city of New York, and the principal at the same place; said bonds to be due and payable in not less than twenty nor more than fifty years from their date. Said bonds to be sold at not less than their par value.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

CHAP. 602.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the village of Havana, in the town of Montour, in the county of Schuyler, and to repeal its present charter," passed April eleventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Passed May 23, 1873; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Sonate und Assembly, clo enact as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-six of an act entitled "An act to incorporute the village of lluvana, in the town of Moutour, in the county of Schuyler, and to repeal its present charter," passed April eleventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, is hereby amended so as to read as

§ 46. The board of trustees shall have power, in their discretion, to authorize and require the grading, paving, planking, flagging, carbing, guttering, reconstruction and repairing of the whole or any part of the sidewalks of any streets or alley in said villago as they shall think proper and according to the grade which shall or may be established by them, and to anthorize and require any street, highway, kno or alley in said villago to be graded, graveled or stoned, paved, carbed and guttered, and to compel the owners or occupants of any lands or lots ndjoining such street, high way, lane or alley or sidewalk, to make such sidewalk or other improvement aforesaid, in front of the lambs or lots of such owner or occupant respectively.
