

STILL ANOTHER BREAK IN THE CROTON MAIN.—About nine o'clock on the morning of May 23d, a water-pipe burst in Worth street, near Church. The water came rushing out with great violence, tearing up the street, and filling a cellar which had been newly dug near by. The Croton Aqueduct Board was notified, and the water shut off.
