Chap. 199.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to amend the charter of Saratoga Springs, passed March twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and for the purpose of securing a supply of pure and wholesome water for the use of said village," passed May fourth, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Passed March 28, 1871; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The trustees of the village of Saratoga Springs are hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of said village in the manner specified in section one of an act entitled "An act to amend the charter of Saratoga Springs, passed March twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and for the purpose of securing a supply of pure and wholesome water for the use of said village," passed May fourth, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, to such amount as may be necessary to complete the works for supplying said village with water, not exceeding, however, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars in addition to the amount authorized to be issued by said act. All the provisions of said act applicable to the issuing, negotiation and use of such bonds shall be applicable to the bonds hereby authorized to be issued.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
