

FENN & CO., PRINTERS TO THE STATE. 1851. thirty-six perches, to a white oak tree on lands owned by Jacob Horner; thence north eighty degrees, east one hundred and forty perches, to a post at the Bedford road; thence along the south-west side of said road thirty-three degrees, west one hundred and seventy-six perches, to a post near the said Horner's barn; thence crossing said Bedford road twenty-two and a-half degrees, east thirty-eight perches, to a stump; thence north twenty-one degrees, west fifty-six perches, to a stump at the corner of Johustown and Conemaugh boroughs.

SECTION 2. That all those parts of the township of Conemaugh Relative to part included within the foregoing limits, and not heretofore included in of Conemaugh said borough, shall constitute a part of the election and school district township. of the borough of Johnstown.

AN ACT

To repeal the second proviso of the second section of "An Act to incorporate the Bedford Water Company.

SECTION 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the second provise of the second section of "An Act to incorporate the Bedford Water Company," approved the sixth day of May, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
