A SUPPLEMENT

To the act to incorporate the Chestnut Hill Water Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Chestnut Hill water company is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of forty thousand dollars, on mortgage of their lands, works, property and corporate franchises, and to issue bonds of the company to that amount, to be secured by said mortgage, payable at such time or times as the board of managers shall appoint.

May borrow money and mortgage property.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of the act incorporating said Chestnut Hill water company, passed April twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, that the works and property of said company should be located on Chestnut Hill, in Philadelphia and Montgomery counties, to supply the inhabitants thereof, and of the neighborhood adjacent thereto, with water; and the restrictions in the second section of the said act contained, not to extend the pipes beyond Miller's lane, nor beyond Allen's lane, are hereby repealed.
