A Supplement

To the act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Easton Water Company, approved the twenty-fourth day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, and the supplements to said act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the par value of the stock of said company shall be fifteen dollars per share, instead of thirty-five dollars, as named in the supplement to said act, approved the fifteenth day of January, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

An Act

Relative to the terms of members of the councils of the city of Philadelphia.

WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen as to who are members of the councils of the city of Philadelphia, under existing laws, between the first day of January and the first Monday in January, in those years not commencing on Monday :

And whereas, The organization of councils is now, by law, fixed for the first Monday of January, in each year, and it is desirable that the old members should continue in office until their successors are duly qualified ; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That in any year when the first day of January does not fall on Monday, the terms of all members of the councils of the
