A Supplement

To an act to incorporate the Venango Water Company, approved the fourth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Venango Water Company are hereby authorized to increase their capital stock, from time to time, to an amount or amounts necessary to extend and complete their works, and pay any debts which are now or may hereafter be created. Authorized to increase capital stock.

SECTION 2. That at any election of officers for said company, each share of stock shall entitle the owner thereof to one vote, either in person or by proxy. Stock, how voted at elections.

An Act

To incorporate the Scranton and Olyphant Boulevard Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That George Coray, Lewis Jones, S. M. Nash, H. S. Pierce, James S. Slocum, ——— Filer, H. K. Grant, Edward Dalph and David Voyle, or any five of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books and receive subscriptions and organize a company, by the name, style and title of the Scranton and Olyphant Boulevard Company, with power to construct a turnpike road, to be well surfaced with broken stone and gravel, from the intersection of Gibson street with Madison avenue, at Fairhaven, in the city of Scranton, to a point at or near the depot at Olyphant, on the Delaware and Commissioners. Title. Construction of turnpike authorized.
