## An act

To provide for payment of the expenses attending the trial of the issue upon the charter of the Harrisburg canal, Fire Insurance, and Water dompany.

SECT. 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the auditor general of this commonwealth, be and he hereby is authorised and required to examine and correct all accounts and claims of the officers of the supreme court, jurors and witnesses and any others who have rendered services on behalf of the commonwealth, upon the issues formed by the said court in pursuance of an act of assembly, entitled "An act to try the validity of the charter of the Harrisburg Canal, Fire Insurance and Water company," and that when said claims shall have been approved by the auditor general, he shall draw orders for the respective sums found due, which shall be paid by the state treasurer: Provided, that the fees of counsel shall not exceed one hundred and fifty dollars and all other charges and costs shall be regulated by the present fee bill.
