AN ACT

To incorporate the Loudon Water Company.

Commissioners.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Hezekiah Easton, John Mullen, Joseph H. M'Clintic, John Beaver, Peter Stenger, William M'Grath, Jonathan Wright, Casper Mentz, Samuel Burgess and H. C. Keyser, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or a majority of them are hereby authorized to carry into effect the establishment of a water company, to be located in the town of Loudon, in the county of Franklin, with a capital stock of five thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of ten dollars each, to be organized, managed and governed as provided by an act, entitled "An Act to provide for the incorporation of gas and water companies," approved the eleventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fiftyseven, and be subject to all the restrictions and provisions, together with all the rights and privileges contained in said act.

Section 2. That the said company shall have power to lease, purchase or acquire the water works now in operation in the said town of Loudon, together with all the water pipes, stocks, reservoirs and fixtures, on procuring from the present owners release of their respective interests in and to the same.
