### CHAPTER CV.

An Ordinance providing for lighting the city of Pittsburgh with gas

Whereas, the Mayor, aldermen and citizens of Pittsburgh of the one part, and William R. Griffith of the other part, have, by articles dated this day, entered into stipulations for lighting the said city by means of gas, as by the said articles, reference thereto being had, will more fully and at large appear, which articles being read and considered in the select and common councils of the city of Pittsburgh, are satisfactory as well to those councils as to the said Griffith, and are now ready for execut-

Wherefore, Be it ordained and enacted, &c. #### CHAPTER CVI.

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to borrow a further sum of twenty thousand dollars.

I. That the Mayor of the city be, and he is hereby authorized to borrow on loan, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, and to issue therefor certificates under the scal of the corporation of one hundred dollars each, bearing an interest of not more than six per Certificates centum per annum, which interest shall be made payable half yearly, at the Bank of Pittsburgh, except so much as may be borrowed in Philadelphia, the interest on which interest to be shall be paid semi-annually at the bank of the United States, in Philadelphia. And the certificates so issued, Bank of Pitts-shall be signed by the Mayor, and counter-signed by the treasurer, and shall be severally transferable by the subscribers or their legal attorney, executors, administrators paid or redu- or assigns, by endorsement thereon, at the office, and in cal until 1st the presence of the treasurer of the city for the time being,
