An Act

Relating to keeping in repair the pipes which supply Rebersburg, in Centre county, with water and for other purposes.

Penalty if commissioners (respecting a public well in Rebersburg)neglect their duties.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the Secate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That if any of the commissioners authorised to be elected by the citizens of Rebersburg by the eighth section of an act, entitled "An act authorising the crection of certain dams in navigable streams, for erecting a bridge over Swatara creek. declaring certain creeks public highways, respecting a public well in Burgettstown, and for other purposes," shall neglect or refuse to discharge the several duties enjoined on him, by the said act, he shall torfeit and pay a fine of ten dollars to be recovered as debts of similar amount are now recoverable.

Election of commissioners.

Duties.

Auditors of Salt Lick township, **Tayette** county to view and report whether the bridge over Indian creek is completed according to conrract.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said commissioners shall be elected annually on the first Monday in April, and shall have full power and authority to enact by-laws, and make such other regulations as may be necessary for the preservation and re-laying of the pipes which supply the said town with water.

SECT. 3. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,

That the auditors of Salt Lick township, Fayette county. are hereby authorised and required to view and report to the supervisors of the roads of said township, whether the bridge over Indian creek, at or near St. John's furnace, in the township aforesaid, is completed agreeably to contract and the act to which this is a supplement.
