NOW KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the power and authority to me given by law, I, *Frank S. Patterson*,
Governor of the said Commonwealth, DO, BY THESE PRESENTS, which I have caused to be made PATENT, and sealed with the Great Seal
of the State, create and erect the subscribers to the stock of the said corporation, for the number of shares for them subscribed, to wit:

all other laws of this Commonwealth.
