

# ACTS AND RESOLVES,

PASSED AT THE

JANUARY SESSION, 1876.

The Chapters of the Public Laws are numbered continuously from the General Statutes, Revision of 1872.

## CHAPTER 515.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 246 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES.

Passed Feb.  
11, 1876.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 246 is hereby amended by striking out therefrom the words : " For entry of every writ, action, appeal and suit in equity, .25."

Fees in Su-  
preme Court.

SEC. 2. Sections 18 and 21 of said chapter 246 are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 537.

Passed April  
18, 1876.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT, ENTITLED, "AN ACT FOR SUPPLYING THE TOWN OF PAWTUCKET WITH PURE WATER," IT BEING CHAPTER 491 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

Town of Pawtucket—introduction of pure water into.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 491 of the Public Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word "river" in the third line the words "Grant's brook in Cumberland."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.

## CHAPTER 538.

Passed April  
19, 1876.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 219 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, "OF PARTITION OF ESTATES IN COMMON AND JOINT TENANCY, AND OF OTHER ACTIONS CONCERNING SUCH ESTATES."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

Of sales of estates on partition.

SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 219 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words, "next preceding section," in the last line thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "eighteenth section of this chapter."

SEC. 2. Section 21 of said chapter 219 is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

## CHAPTER 539.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 282 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS, ENTITLED, "AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 137, TITLE XVIII, OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, 'OF INLAND FISHERIES.'"

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 282 of the Public Laws is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:
