CHAP. XXXVIII.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and Aldermen of the town of Nashville, to raise a sum of money by Lottery, for the purpose of bringing water into said town.

BE it enacted by the General Assembly of the state Lottery author of Tennessee, That the Mayor and Aldermen iced. of the town of Nathville, be, and they are hereby vested with full power and authority to make, and proceed to the drawing and concluding of a Lottery for the purpose of bringing water into the faid town, under fuch rules, rethrictions and regulations, as they may deem proper: Provided, they do not by faid Lottery, gain more than the nett fum of eight thousand dollars, which faid monies, or se much thereof as they may raife by virtue of faid Lottery, shall form a fund to be by them expended in bringing water into faid town, and through the different streets thereof,

for the general benefit of the inhabitants.

Sec. 2nd. Be it enacted. That the faid Mayor and Aldermen that be, and are hereby made able and capable in law, to have, purchase, receive, posses, enjoy and retain to themselves and successors, any lands, tenements, hereditaments, goods, chattels and effects of what kind, nature or quality foever, and the fame to dispose of in the best manner they may deem proper, for bringing water into faid town and streets as aforefaid, and they by the name of the Mayor and Alderman of the Corporation of the town of Nathville, may fue and be fued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, defend and be defended, in courts of record or elsewhere; and thall mercover have power to make, ordain or establish, any bye law or laws, ordinance or ordinances, as to them may appear necessary and convenient, for the purpole of bringing water into faid town

and streets as aforesaid, and for keeping the pipes in order, and preventing them from being injured, and doing such other things as to them may seem right, touching the principles aforesaid: *Provided*, the same be not contrary to the constitution and laws of this state.

Bond to be gi-

Sec. 3d. Be it enalted, That the aforesaid Mayor and Aldermen, shall give bond and security to the chairman of the court of the county of Davidson, in the sum of ten thousand dollars, well and truly to apply the monies produced by said Lottery to the aforesaid purposes, and that they will also pay over the several prizes to the persons who may be entitled to receive the same.

Assembly, that the drawing of private Lotteries hath become a serious and alarming evil, relaxing the sinews of industry, and encouraging habits of idleness and dissipation

DE it enacted by the General Assembly of the state O of Tennessee, That if any person or persons thall erect, fet up, or expose to be drawn, or shall cause or procure to be erected, fet up, exposed or drawn, any lottery by way of chances, either by numbers, figures or tickets. or shall make, print, advertise or publish, or cause to be made, printed, advertised or published, proposals or schemes for advancing small sums of money by several persons, to be divided by them as prizes, or shall deliver out, or cause, procure or permit, to be delivered out, tickets to the perfon advancing fuch fums, to entitle them to a share of the money to advanced, according to fuch proposals or schemes, or hall expose to fale any houses, lands, plate, jewels or other goods or chattels, by any game, method or device whatfoever, depending upon, or to be determined by way of lottery or drawing, whether it be out of a box or wheel, or by any machine, engine, or device of chance whatloever, or shall be adventurers in or pay any monies or other confideration, or any ways contribute unto any fuch Lottery or Lotteries, fale or fales, fuch person or persons, and every or either of them, on being convicted thereof on the oath of one or more credible witness or witnesses, or on the confession of the party or parties accused, shall serfeit and

pay double the amount of the fum contained in the scheme .
