The Age says the iron tank of the Houston Water Works Company is to be, when completed, seventy-eight feet high, of which lifty-two feet is now up. It will hold 175,000 gallons of water. That is to be a reserve "reservoir," and to furnish water to the pipes at any time, when by any kind of chance the pipes cannot be supplied by the ongine. The tank is to be finished by the 1st of July.
