Charter of Clerks and Salesmen United Brotherhood

State of Texas } Be it remembered that on the 13th day of
Brewer County } January - A. D. 1883 - We, the undersigned,
H. A. Messel - J. B. Lightfoot - C. C. Buckner - L. J. Mall -
W. E. Snodgrass - A. Pear - M. A. Clark - and Robert Thompson -
citizens of the State of Texas and residing within the
County of Brewer, by voluntary association have created
have created, and by these presents do create, a body
corporate and politic under the corporate name of the
Clerks and Salesmen United Brotherhood - for the
support of a certain charitable and benevolent under-
taking. Hereinafter set forth in accordance with the laws
of the State of Texas - in such cases made and provided
as set forth in Title XX of the Revised Civil Statutes of
said State, and do here now propose and adopt the
following Charter for the government of said Corporation -
to wit:

First:

The name of said Corporation shall be the -
"Clerks and Salesmen United Brotherhood."

Second:

This Corporation is formed for the purpose of uniting
fraternally all acceptable white persons, who are commonly
known as employees or employers of any kind not admitted to
