

To the Gen. Assembly of Va.

The Petition of the undersigned, Trustees and other Citizens of Blacksburg in the County of Jefferson, respectfully sheweth,

That for many years the greatest inconvenience has been experienced by the Citizens of said Town, from the very limited supply of water.

Large sums of money have been expended in the digging of wells, & the construction of pumps, but owing to the depth of the water in the earth & the weakness of the streams very small supplies have been obtained.

Your Petitioners have ascertained that an abundant supply, for all the purposes of said Town, may be obtained from some one of the many Springs in the vicinity of said Town, and that it may be introduced by means of Iron Pipes.

As this, however, would be attended with a much greater outlay of means than could be raised by the annual assessments upon said Town your Petitioners respectfully pray the passage of a Law authorizing the Trustees of said Town to borrow money upon the credit of the Corporation, not exceeding five thousand dollars, for the purposes aforesaid.
