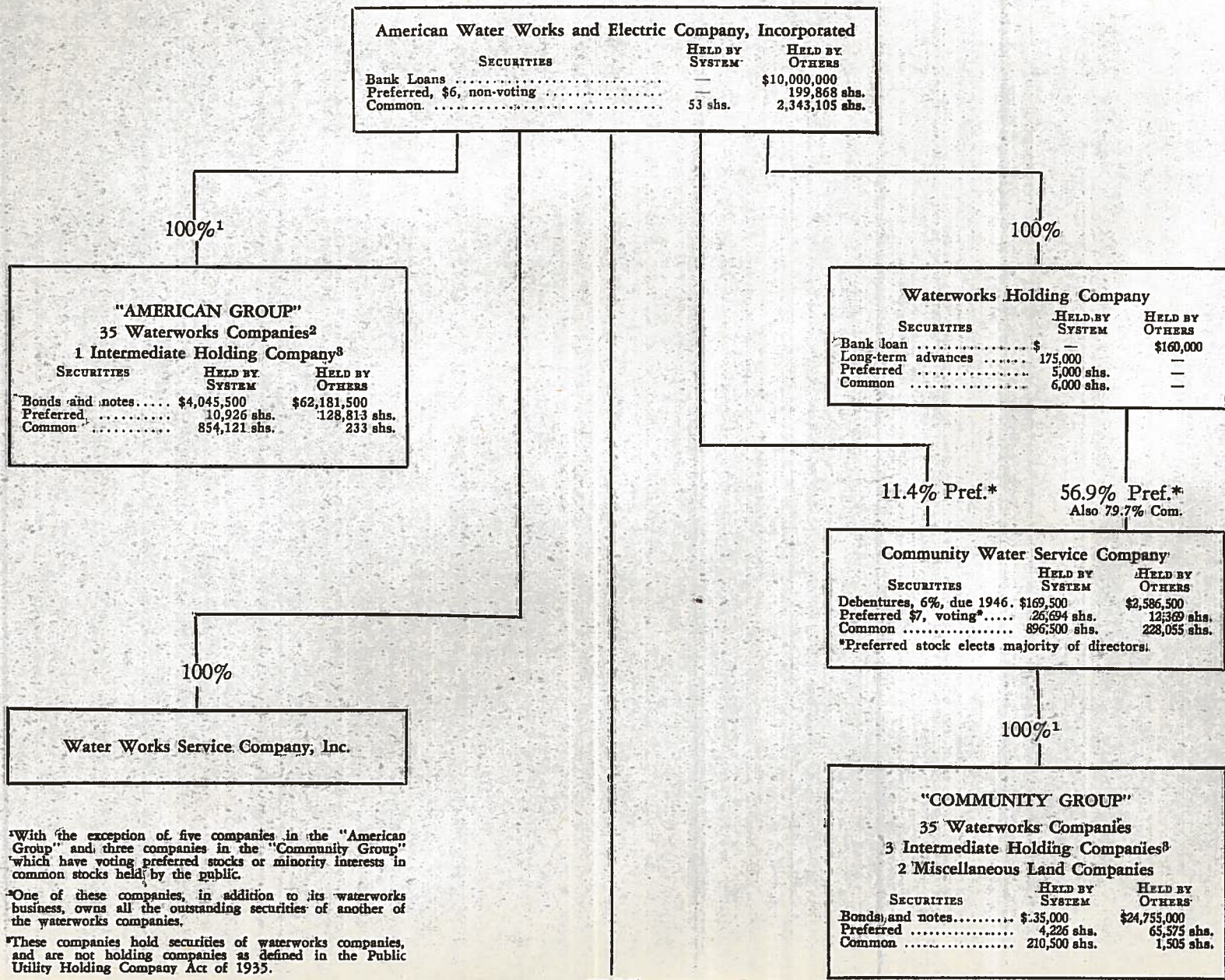


**CORPORATE CHART OF THE AMERICAN SYSTEM**

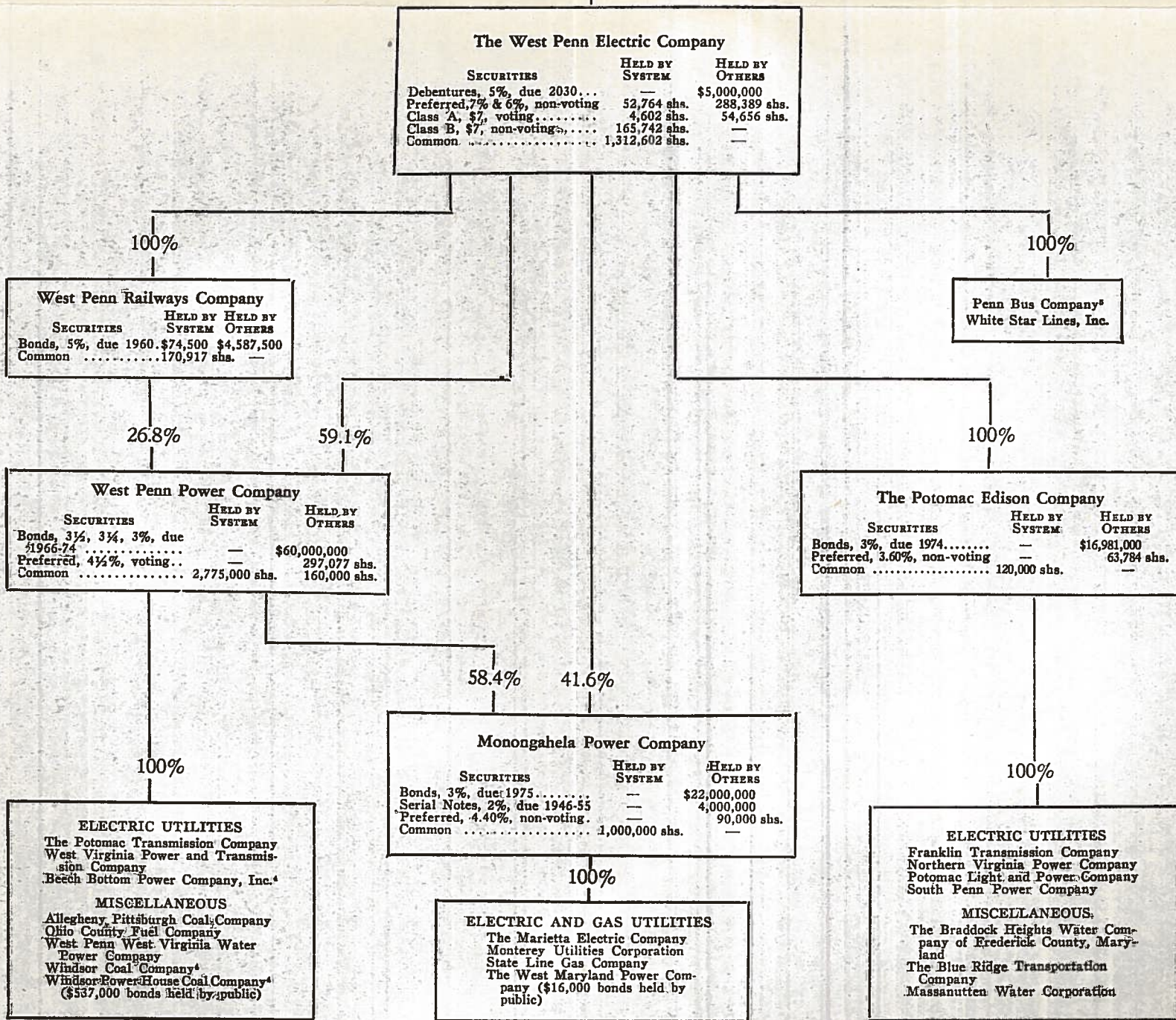
