Its first operations were confined to Swarthmore, Delaware County; since that date it has rapidly grown and acquired by purchase or occupation a large section of the suburban country surrounding Philadelphia. The towns supplied are as follows: Swarthmore, Rutledge, Morton, Clifton Heights, Adamsford, Aldan, Llanerch, Lansdowne, Fernwood, Darby, Llanwellyn, Holmes, Colwyn, Sharon Hill, Collingdale, Norwood, Glenolden, Moore, Prospect Park, Ridley Park, Milmont, Fairview, Eddystone, Bala, Cynwyd, Overbrook, Merion, Wynnewood, Haverford, Narberth, Ardmore, Bryn Mawr, Rosemont and many other smaller places.

The water supplied is the purest taken from Crum Creek and filtered and from artesian wells. All the pumping machinery is of the latest type, and ample storage capacity insures an abundant supply. More than 3,000 houses are now taking water.

The principal office is in the Fidelity Mutual Life Association Building, No. 112 North Broad Street, Philadelphia, 2d floor; J. W. Hawley, President.

For the accommodation of its customers, two main offices are located—one at Morton, with W. E. Rowland, Superintendent; and one at Bryn Mawr, Elias Hart, Superintendent. Other local offices are located at Ridley Park and Darby.
