THE DEEPEST WELL IN THE WORLD.—The St. Louis *Democrat* says: We publish a statement made by the Louisville *Courier*, a few days ago, that the deepest well in the world was the artesian well of Messrs. Dupont, in that city—1,900 feet in depth. We beg leave to inform the *Courier* that the artesian well of Belcher & Bros., in this city, [St. Louis,] is now 2,200 feet deep, being 300 feet deeper than that of Messrs. Dupont. It will be carried to a still greater depth, until such water as can be used for refining purposes in the Belcher & Bros. sugar refinery, shall have been reached.
