We are glad to find that the immense water wheel, erected by Messrs. Perry & Woodworth, works to a charm, in fact, it works with the precision of clock-work. The buckets, patent valve, the invention of the contractors, are a success; they lift up four and a half gallons and deposit it in the reservoir, without spilling a drop. The water thence is conveyed to the aqueduct. The work reflects great credit on our worthy Mayor, who suggested, and has successfully carried out the plan, as well as upon all concerned in the oversight and management of the details. We hope the Council will make the additional appropriations necessary, to enable the citizens to derive the full benefit of this great improvement.
